
God is normally on our side bringing us beautiful sunshine. When sitting outside, please be respectful of the graves and refrain from sitting, on or leaning against them.

Drinks Vouchers - There is NO CASH on the bars. We do however exchange beer/cider, crisps, nuts and soft drinks for vouchers. These can be bought in £6 (3 drinks) or £12 (6 drinks) sheets from the welcome stall at the entrance. Cash or Card is fine 1 Token can be used for ½ pint, 1 soft drink or 2 snacks. 2 Tokens for an alcohol free can of beer. We can also refund left over money on vouchers (unless you decide to donate it).

Food outlets - take payment by cash/ card. Drinks tokens cannot be redeemed from the food outlets.



Food for Thought - Food for thought will be here on Friday 12th & Saturday 13th May selling their Fish and Chip shop range plus their amazing half and Quarter pounder burgers as well as a vege/ vegan option. Look out for their pork baps this year.

THIS YEAR'S CHARITIES

When the Russian forces invaded Ukraine in February last year we decided that doing nothing was not an option. Within a few weeks the Swindon Humanitarian Aid Partnership (SHAP) was born. We have now collected, sorted, boxed and delivered over 870 tonnes of aid into Eastern Ukraine - where the impact of war is at its worst. In addition, we support the growing number of Ukrainian visitors to Swindon with housing, education places, benefit applications and general understanding of the systems in the UK.

Our Candles for Ukraine campaign struck a chord over the Christmas period. It is a response to a desperate need in Ukraine for heating and lighting. Wax is melted down to make trench candles which can be used for cooking and heating. Through meetings in the House of Lords and some time with General Sir Mike Jackson we have been promised dozens of buses that we are converting into mobile field hospitals. We will deliver them to Ukraine for use by both civilian and army personnel. The first bus is nearly complete with hospital beds, heart monitors, and a generator installed.
